TRANSFER CREDITS

Students with college-level coursework or testing credit (AP/IB/CLEP/ PSEO/CITS/coursework taken following high school graduation) may be eligible to transfer these credits to UMD. To see how college and test credits may transfer to UMD, please visit **Transferology.com** and follow the steps on the back of this card.

UMD's liberal education requirements will be waived for students who complete an Associate of Arts degree or the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum at a regionally accredited post-secondary institution.

- 1. Create a free account at www.transferology.com
- 2. Choose Will My Courses Transfer to see how your courses transfer to another institution; or Find a Replacement Course to find a course you can take elsewhere for credit at your current school
- **3.** Enter the institution's name from where you received, are currently receiving, or will receive credit
- 4. Enter the semester and year the course was taken (e.g. Fall 2018)
- 5. Enter the course indicator/prefix (e.g. BIOL, ENG) and course number, which can be found on your transcript

- Add all of the courses for which you will be getting credit to My Courses list
- 7. Click the Search for Matches button
- 8. Type University of Minnesota Duluth into the search bar
- 9. Look at Matches, Misses, and Maybes for UMD to see how your credits transfer
- If any come back as Maybes, click the button to Request Information. A UMD admissions counselor will respond to your inquiry about transfer credits
