Classes officially start on Monday, the 26th of August 2024.

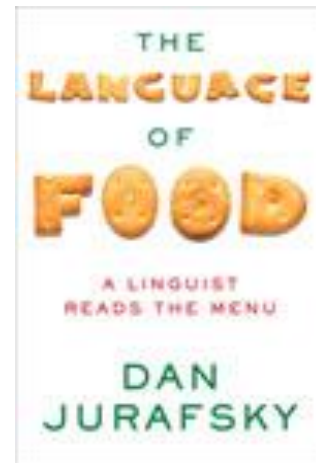
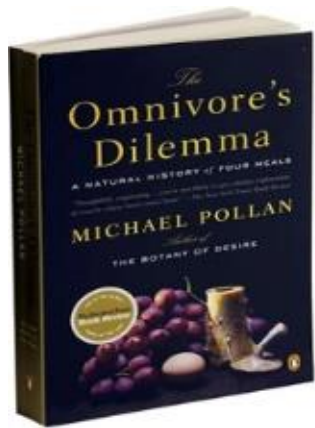
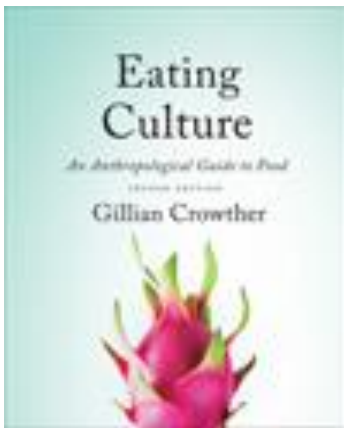

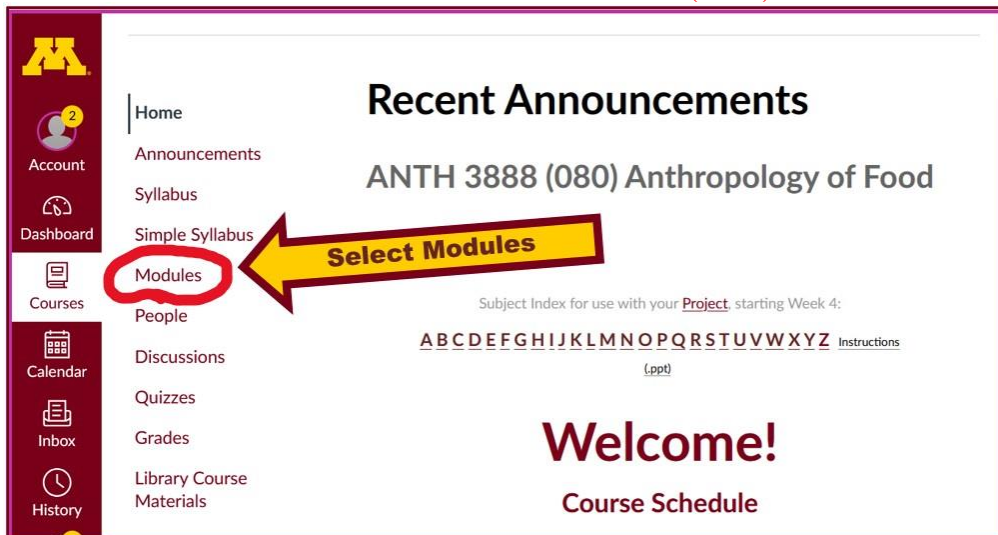
It will take you to your Canvas Dashboard which looks something like this . . .

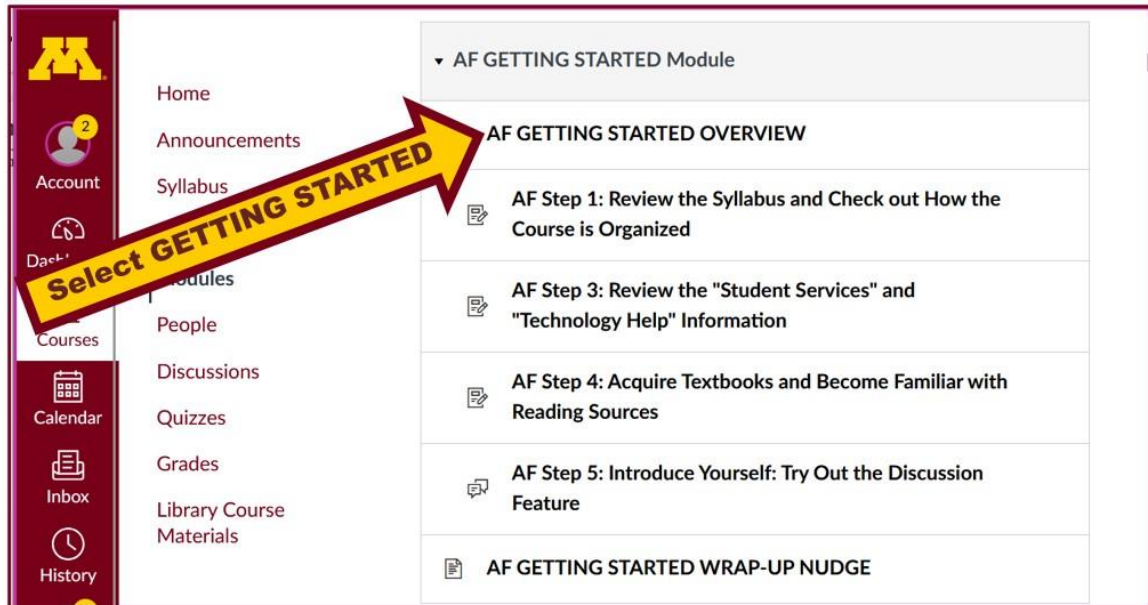
Clicking on the “ANTH 3888” image will take you to your Canvas “Home Page”, and from there select your “Modules” file. It will look something like this . . .
